Underground Railroad at Hale Farm & Village

“I knew a fair amount about the Underground Railroad, or so I thought. But it wasn't until... Hale Farm & Village's interactive program, in which I assumed the role of an African-American slave, that I started to comprehend how terrifying it must have been for those trying to escape the South in search of freedom.”

In this interactive program, visitors travel to the year 1852 and become fugitives fleeing from the bonds of slavery. They experience, first hand, what slaves encountered during their bid for freedom, and on their journey meet people – abolitionists, slave hunters, free blacks and Quakers – some of whom are helpful, some indifferent and others treacherous.
